When it is time for the puppy to start their wean off of the prescription diet, please use the following chart to identify the ratio of each food needed per meal. These ratios below are the percentages of the normal amount of food the dog is currently eating NOT fractions of a cup. For example, if the puppy is eating  $1 \frac{3}{4}$  cups of food, then on day one, the dog would be approximately getting  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of the regular diet and  $1 \frac{1}{3}$  cups of the prescriptions. Please note that if your dog is not eating even rations, the amount of food would be as close to the fractions listed below as possible. You will end up at the normal amount of food at the end of the weaning period.
