

Pruritis Scoring Chart

| Grade 10/10 | Severe continuous itching - The dog cannot be stopped from itching without physical restraint and itching happens all the time regardless of surroundings. |
| Grade 8/10 | Prolonged intermittent itching episodes - Episodes disrupt the dog's eating, play, exercise and sleep. Itching occurs even when dog is distracted. |
| Grade 6/10 | Moderate itching - Frequent episodes occur throughout the day. But, the dog does not itch when eating, playing or exercising. The dog <i>can be distracted</i> out of itching. Itching does occur at night when observed. |
| Grade 4/10 | Mild itching - Semi-frequent episodes of mild itching occur. Dog doesn't itch while playing, exercising or being distracted. |
| Grade 2/10 | Very mild itching - Occasional episodes of itching. Dog is only slightly itchier than normal. Itching has become noticeable. |
| Grade 0/10 | Normal dog - Itching is infrequent and does not rise to the level of being noticed. |
